### ULTIMATE FRISBEE CASE STUDY


This case study starts with a simple HTML document that has no CSS. The case study iteratively modifies the HTML and CSS to improve the layout.

## **VERSION 1 – Modifications over version 0?**

We have modified our initial HTML code to add in *divisions* and *spans*.

- 1) We have changed all the fonts by modifying body.
- 2) We have created div with #ids about News (News area), Announcements (Marty's Ultimate Page are), Calendar (Events).
- 3) We have created spans about the headers in the Announcements and use class “announcement”. (Why class and not ID? Because there are more than one item with this class).
- 4) They create a “firstword” class that is used in spans about the first word in the announcements.
