eCheck Reports

What are eCheck Reports?

- Required for four eChecks:
 - 06B, 08A, 10B, and 12B
- Summary of approach to solve eCheck
- Plain text txt file (NOT Word doc file)
- No code this is not a Java file
- State applicable classes, methods, identifiers
- Consider it a guide to a correct solution

Why write eCheck Reports?

- Students get "correct" eCheck by
 - Seeing other's code
 - Trial and error
- Evaluate student understanding of techniques
- Practice problem-solving
- Skills beneficial for
 - Programming in a team
 - Writing documentation

How will they be graded?

- York's 9-point scale:
