Reminder: Academic Honesty

- “Academic honesty is essentially giving credit where credit is due. And not misrepresenting what you have done and what work you have produced.”

— *Department of CSE Academic Honesty Guidelines*

- Examples of academic dishonesty:
 - copying someone else’s work (assignments, tests, reports, etc. in part or in whole) without mentioning the source
 - modifying a marked test/assignment and then requesting a remarking
 - printing the correct output(s) using only `printf` without actually writing the code according to the given specs

Academic Dishonesty: Penalties

- Calibrated according to the severity of the offence and Senate policy.
- Grade reduction (e.g., from B- to C)
- Transcript notation
- Suspension from the University
- In all cases, a course may not be dropped.
