(ii) On the day of the lecture	
<ul> <li>* meet the speaker</li> <li>* escort them to the classroom</li> <li>* provide them with water (see me beforehand for same)</li> <li>* make sure that their audio-visual system works</li> <li>* introduce them to the class</li> <li>* after their lecture, if not already done by the speaker, ask for questions</li> <li>* when done, thank the speaker</li> </ul>
