

*\*\* We are using LAS 1006 – This is a general purpose computing lab, which also doubles as a 'drop-in' lab for any work conducted outside regular lab sessions*

*\*\* This outlines when lab access is blocked for regular course labwork. E.g. LAS 1006 is relatively free on Tuesday (until 4pm). Useful if you wish to access the lab to work ahead/catch up on lab work, or programming practice outside of formal lab times.*

### **PRISM Account Setup [IMPORTANT]:**

In order to obtain a Prism account, you will use the Activ8 web application. You must have a [Passport York](#) account prior to obtaining a Prism account. Your Passport York account username will be your Prism username.

There are several ways to obtain a Prism account:

1. On the Internet: Point your web browser to <http://www.eecs.yorku.ca/activ8>
2. In person, in LAS1006 or LAS1004: Enter 'activ8' as the login name, hit enter for password.
3. In person, in LAS1002: Enter 'activ8' both as the login name and password.
